To make weaving tool:

1 piece of 26-gauge round wire of any colour

1.5 yards in length

4.5- to 5-cm card (e.g., credit card)

6 inches of 2-cm dowel

Elastic band

To make earrings:

2 pieces of 26-gauge smokey quartz round

wire 1.5 yards in length

Twenty 2-mm faceted beads

2 pieces of fine chain 1.5 cm in length

2 earring hooks

On loan from instructor:

Draw plate

Assembly Instructions

To make weaving tool:

- 1. Using a card (e.g., a credit card) of 4.5-5 cm in diameter wrap the wire of any colour around it 10 times.
- 2. Remove the wrappings from the card and wrap the excess wire around one end (**Photo 1**).
- 3. Shape the 10 loops over the dowel like a hat so the loops are even. Hold the loops in place on the dowel by an elastic band or tape. (**Photo 2**)

To make earrings:

- 1. Take 1 piece of the 26-gauge smokey quartz wire 1.5 yards in length and straighten with nylon jaw pliers. Then make a loop at the end (**Photo 3**) and then place this loop through one of the loops on the dowel (**Photo 4**).
- 2. Using this smokey quartz wire, continue making loops on the other 9 loops on the dowel, leaving the tail on the outside (**Photos 5 and 6**).
- 3. Start 2nd row by bringing the smokey wire around the base of the 1st loop of the 1st row to make a loop. Continue the same way along the 2nd row (**Photo 7**) and then a 3rd row. On the 4th row after every 2 loops, add a bead (total of 5 beads). (**Photo 8**)
- 4. Complete 3 more rows without beads.

- 5. On the 8th row between the 2 added beads above (**Photo 9**), add a bead and continue for another total of 5 beads.
- 6. Complete 3 more rows without beads for a total of 11 rows. (Photo 10)
- 7. Slip end of weaving wire through first loop of previous row and cut a tail of 6-8 inches.
- 8. Remove weaving from dowel.
- 9. Slip weaving through biggest draw plate hole (**Photo 11**).
- 10. Form curved bottom with fingers (**Photo 12**) and pick up the rest of the loops with the 6-8 inch tail. (**Photos 13 and 14**). Cut off end of tail and turn inside with round nose pliers.
- 11. At the other end, cut off the dowelling loops (**Photo 15**) and form with fingers the other curved end.
- 12. Pick up the loops at this end with a spare wire (Photo 16).
- 13. Twist the two top wires together (**Photo 17**).
- 14. Use round nose pliers and make a loop at the top of the earring (**Photo 18**). Wrap excess wire around the bottom of the loop and cut.
- 15. Attach the chain and earring hook (Photo 19).
- 16. Make the 2nd earring following the steps of this section and of similar shape.

To add weaving wire:

- 1. Make a loop as in **Photo 3** and add to the last loop with one tail one way and the other tail the other way inside of all of the weaving (**Photo 20**).
- 2. After a row or so of weaving, cut off the inner tails.
